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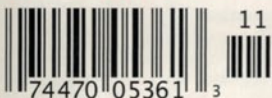
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## Bug power Radial supply new StageBug box for miking up acoustic musicians

**A**lways on hand to help out the flustered FOH engineer with a problem-solving DI, splitter or switcher, Radial Engineering have unveiled their latest helpful little box. The StageBug SB48UB is designed to work alongside the Radial Tonebone PZ-Pre, an all-singing, all-dancing preamp and EQ pedal for acoustic instruments that lets you blend the signals from two different pickups. But what if you want to mix your guitar's piezo pickup, for example, with a condenser



mic? That's where the SB48UB comes in. Powered by a 15V DC mains adaptor, this rugged, Canadian-made unit supplies 48V phantom power via its balanced XLR input (switchable to 12V for electret condenser mics), with both balanced XLR and unbalanced quarter-inch jack outputs at the other end. Potentially useful anywhere portable phantom power is needed, the StageBug SB48UB is available now priced \$150.
